

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

April 10, 2017

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in special session at 2:00 p.m. with all members present.

The Board, as a Board of Canvassers, canvassed the results of the Hartley-Melvin-Sanborn Special Election held April 4, 2017 with the following results: Director District 1 to fill the vacancy – Ryan Haack; For the proposition: Shall the Board of Directors of the Hartley-Melvin-Sanborn Community School District, in the Counties of O'Brien, Osceola, Dickinson and Clay, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue general obligation bonds in an amount not exceeding \$16,500,000 for the purpose of furnishing, equipping, constructing, improving, repairing and renovating school buildings and improving the sites therefor at the school district's existing school buildings in Sanborn and Hartley, to include: an addition to and renovations of the existing Sanborn middle school campus, including new middle school classrooms, renovated art, music, and library areas, a competitive gym and site improvements; and an addition to and renovations of the Hartley high school campus to include a new elementary school addition, renovations and upgrades to the high school facilities to include new industrial technology areas and new wrestling facilities, new parking areas and other site improvements? Yes – 904 No – 615 Measure defeated as 60% was required for passage.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Bootsma to adjourn to April 11, 2017. Motion carried by all ayes.
