

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

March 7, 2017

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Bootsma to approve the proceedings of February 28, 2017. Motion carried by all ayes.

The Chair opened a hearing at 9:05 a.m. on the proposed expansion of a confinement feeding operation owned by Two B Hog Inc. in Section 9, Baker Township. The expansion will be to increase animal units only. The Animal Unit Capacity of the confinement operation after the expansion will be 1,880 (4,100 head of finishing swine and 2,400 head of nursery swine). There were no objections presented. The Chair closed the hearing at 9:10 a.m.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded Steensma to approve the expansion of the Two B Hog Inc. swine confinement facility in Section 9, Baker Township. Motion carried by all ayes.

At 9:15 a.m. a hearing was held on the amendment to the current fiscal year budget. There were no objections presented. The Chair closed the hearing at 9:23 a.m.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by McDowell to adopt the amended Fiscal 2017 County Budget as published. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Bootsma to adopt the amended appropriations resolution for the Fiscal 2017 budget. Motion carried by all ayes.

At 9:30 a.m. a hearing was held on the Fiscal 2018 proposed county budget. There were no objections presented. The Chair closed the hearing at 9:45 a.m.

O'BRIEN COUNTY RESOLUTION 2017-9  
RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, O'BRIEN COUNTY, IOWA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Section 306.41 of the Code of Iowa to temporarily close sections of road by formal resolution when they deem necessary for construction, maintenance, or natural disaster,

AND WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, County of O'Brien, have determined that the following section of road should be temporarily closed due to bridge construction:

**County Gravel Road: Silver Avenue between 480<sup>th</sup> and 490<sup>th</sup> Streets (1 mile)**  
**And**  
**County Gravel Road: Sorrel Avenue between 480<sup>th</sup> and 490<sup>th</sup> Streets (1 mile)**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the above described roads be closed temporarily in the manner described below.

"ROAD CLOSED" signs shall be placed on both ends of the described segment of roads, and they shall remain in place until the construction is completed.

At 10:00 a.m. a hearing was held on the proposed vacation of an O'Brien County road described as follows: A portion of 290th Street between Monroe Avenue and Northwest Boulevard. More specifically described as follows: The South 33.00 feet of the Southwest Quarter of Section 8, Township 97 North, Range 42 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, O'Brien County, Iowa, except the West 33.00 feet thereof; and the North 33.00 feet of the Northwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 97 North, Range 42 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, O'Brien County, Iowa, except the West 33.00 feet thereof. The Chair closed the hearing at 10:07 a.m.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Friedrichsen to adopt O'Brien County Resolution No. 2017-7; a resolution to vacate a county road described as follows: A portion of 290th Street between Monroe Avenue and Northwest Boulevard. More specifically described as follows: The South 33.00 feet of the Southwest Quarter of Section 8, Township 97 North, Range 42 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, O'Brien County, Iowa, except the West 33.00 feet thereof; and the North 33.00 feet of the Northwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 97 North, Range 42 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, O'Brien County, Iowa, except the West 33.00 feet thereof. Motion carried by all ayes.
