

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

November 29, 2016

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Friedrichsen to approve the proceedings of November 22, 2016. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by DeBoom to approve Cindy Thompson as the part time Human Services Custodian at \$12.00 per hour effective November 29, 2016. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by Friedrichsen to approve a claim for general assistance rent to Tanner Lyons for \$300.00. Motion carried by all ayes.

At 10:00 am the Chair opened the hearing on the proposed Drainage District No. 5 Cleanout/Repair project. There were several landowners present for the hearing. Jim Hudson of Hudson Law Firm and Richard Hopper of Jacobson-Westergaard & Associates, Inc. gave an overview of the project and answered questions regarding the repairs in the district.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Farnsworth to set the interest rate at 5% for stamped warrants and also for the drainage assessments on Drainage District No. 5. The District will also have a repayment period of no more than 10 years for the repair project. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Steensma to accept the preliminary engineering report for Drainage District No. 5 presented by Richard Hopper of Jacobson-Westergard & Associates, Inc. Motion carried by all ayes.
