The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Bootsma, seconded by McDowell to approve the proceedings of February 20, 2018. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by Steensma to approve the appointment of Rhea Schmalen as the Auditor's Payroll/Accounts Payable Clerk at \$42,000 per year effective March 1, 2018. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by Bootsma to authorize the EMA Director to submit the grant application for the BETS program for Fiscal 2019. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by McDowell to accept the quote of Ron Drenkow Motors for two 2018 Ford Explorers at \$34,527 each for sheriff's patrol vehicles. Motion carried by all ayes.
