

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

May 1, 2018

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Bootsma, seconded by McDowell to approve the proceedings of April 24, 2018. Motion carried by all ayes.

At 9:05 a.m. a hearing was held on the Larry Jenness confinement expansion. This is for construction of one new 2,640 head deep pit swine finisher building in Section 30, Center Township. The facility will have a total animal unit of 2,916 finishing swine. There were no objections presented. The Chair closed the hearing at 9:06 a.m.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by McDowell to recommend the construction permit application Larry Jenness in Section 30, Center Township be approved. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Bootsma to hold a budget amendment hearing at 9:05 a.m. May 22, 2018 for the County's Fiscal 2018 budget. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by Steensma to adopt O'Brien County Resolution 2018-9; Notice for Destruction of Noxious Weeds. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Bootsma, seconded by McDowell to increase the County Health Insurance premiums effective July 1, 2018 by \$10 per month for single plans and \$20 per month for family plans. The county will pay the increase with the exception that less than full time employees will continue to pay half of the premium needed. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Farnsworth to adopt the following resolution. Motion carried by all ayes.
