

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

August 28, 2018

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by McDowell to approve the proceedings of August 21, 2018. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by McDowell to approve the purchase of vote tablets from Henry M. Adkins & Son, Inc. This is for 10 tablets with a trade in of the old disability machines and also to purchase a mini central scan system for absentee ballots. Total project cost of \$29,190.00. Motion carried by all ayes.

The Board reviewed information on a request for stop signs to be placed at the intersection of 330<sup>th</sup> Street and Polk Avenue. This request was due to a fatality accident at this intersection. There have been no accidents at this location prior to this incident. The Conservation Department is in the process of making improvements to Douma Park which is located near this intersection. The Board decided to revisit this request when the Douma Park updates are completed to see what the traffic patterns are and if controlling this intersection would be appropriate at that time.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by Bootsma to approve the utility construction application of Osceola Rural Water between Sections 16 & 21 in Hartley Township. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Bootsma, seconded by McDowell to reimburse Joshua Haack, who rents the tillable County Farm land, \$181.54. This is for .5423 acres at his per acre rent of \$334.77. The County used this area for concrete storage during the crop year. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Bootsma, seconded by Steensma to pay Dale Fulk and Tim Peelen each \$200 for their services as Drainage Commissioners and Appraisers for Drainage District 5. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by McDowell to authorize the Chairman to sign a letter of support in the amount of \$6,505 for the Fiscal 2019 State Housing Trust Fund application. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by Steensma to adjourn to September 4, 2018. Motion carried by all ayes.
