

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

July 31, 2018

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Bootsma, seconded by McDowell to approve the proceedings of July 24, 2018. Motion carried by all ayes.

The Board received an update from the County Attorney on the official newspaper lawsuit. The court date is set for August 24, 2018.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by Steensma to appoint Doug Julius, Sioux County Engineer as the interim O'Brien County Engineer at \$110 per hour and a mileage reimbursement of \$.50 per mile. This will be memorialized in a 28E agreement that will be presented to the O'Brien and Sioux County Boards within the next two weeks. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by Bootsma to approve the fireworks permit application of Joseph McCarty at the intersection of Starling Avenue & 300th Street. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by McDowell, seconded by Bootsma to approve tile crossing applications of Don Vanden Hull between Sections 29 & 30, Summit Township and Harold Niichel between Sections 20 & 28, Baker Township. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by Steensma to approve the utility construction application of Windstream along Warbler Avenue & 390th Street. Motion carried by all ayes.

Jason Bendixen of Jacobson-Westergard & Associates presented an overview of progress on Drainage District 5. The project is complete and Jayson recommended that the Board set a completion hearing date. Rick Hopper of Jacobson-Westergard & Associates will visit with the Board in a couple weeks with more details to set the hearing date.
