Resolution of the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors

APPROVAL OF WAIVER OF O'BRIEN COUNTY'S RIGHT TO APPEAL ISSUANCE OF FINAL CONSTRUCTION PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CONFINED ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATION BY THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

BE IT RESOLVED by the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Section 1. The O'Brien County Board of Supervisors has received notice from the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) that Hoppe Pork I Site, Facility ID 70265 has been issued a draft permit for the construction of a confined animal feeding operation building on SW ¼ SW ¼ Section 9, Hartley Township in unincorporated O'Brien County.

Section 2. The O'Brien County Board of Supervisors reviewed the construction permit application and the manure management plan and determined that both appeared to be in compliance with the requirements of the Master Matrix, Iowa Code Section 459 and Iowa DNR rules and recommend approval of said application on June 19, 2018.

Section 3. The O'Brien County Board of Supervisors hereby waives its right to appeal the issuance of the final permit within the fourteen (14) day limit from the time of receipt of notice of the issuance of the draft permit.

Section 4. The O'Brien County Board of Supervisors encourages the Iowa DNR to issue the Final Permit immediately upon notification of this waiver.

Section 5. The O'Brien County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Board Chairman to notify the Iowa DNR of this waiver.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
