

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

October 23, 2018

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by Steensma to approve the proceedings of October 16, 2018 with the correction to include the cancellation of the hearing on the Brent Rieck confinement feeding facility that was scheduled for October 16, 2018. The application was withdrawn. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by Bootsma to appoint John Steensma as the O'Brien County representative on the SHIELD board at NW IA Planning & Development. Motion carried by all ayes.

The Board discussed the payment of the publications for proceedings and legal notices that have been held since the filing of a lawsuit over the official newspapers for 2018. A court decision was filed on October 10, 2018 upholding the appointment of the N'West Iowa Review and Sheldon Mail-Sun as the official newspapers for O'Brien County for 2018. Unless ordered otherwise by the court, per Iowa Code 349.14, the Board will approve the payment of these publications at its November 14, 2018 meeting with the normal claim processing for the month.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by McDowell to approve the County's annual Urban Renewal report for Fiscal 2018. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by McDowell, seconded by Bootsma to hold a budget amendment hearing for the County's Fiscal 2019 budget at 9:30 a.m. November 14, 2018. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Farnsworth, seconded by Steensma to approve an application for utility construction for Osceola County Rural Water System in Section 8, Franklin Township. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Bootsma, seconded by McDowell to appoint Boyd Junge as the County's representative for FEMA Inspections and Doug Julius as the alternate representative for FEMA Inspections. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Farnsworth to adjourn to October 30, 2018. Motion carried by all ayes.
