

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

September 28, 2021

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:07 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Friedrichsen to approve the proceedings of September 21, 2021. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Bootsma, seconded by Steensma to approve the following projects from the American Rescue Plan Act funds: Software enhancement to the Beacon website for online tax credit forms - \$8,640; Digitizing the Auditor & Recorder's land transfer books & indexes - \$113,210; Additional cameras in the jail to allow for more segregation and safety - \$46,679.80; a set a side of \$30,000 in the event additional personal protective equipment is needed for a future disaster; NW IA Youth Emergency Services Center for renovations to the facility for better segregation and safety, also 2 transport vehicles due to the increased transportation needs - \$6,619. O'Brien County is a 28E participant in the NW IA Youth Emergency Services Center. Due to the 28E relationship, this is a County owned facility and the allocation is O'Brien County's share of the cost. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Vanden Hull to set the criteria for the American Rescue Plan funds to fund internal projects of the County only with applications due by 4 pm March 31, 2022. Nonprofits would be considered for funding after this deadline as funds are available. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Bootsma to notify Willoway that their application will not be considered at this time. Internal County projects will be the only ones considered at this time. The project may be considered at a later date. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Vanden Hull, seconded by Bootsma to adjourn to October 5, 2021. Motion carried by all ayes.
