**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS FOR THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT.**

**WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the 109 trillion-dollar American Rescue Plan Act and,

**WHEREAS**, O'Brien County applied for and has been received the first tranche of funds for the American Rescue Plan Act totaling \$1,335,679.50.

**WHEREAS**, the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors has reviewed some requests and determined some that will qualify for the American Rescue Plan Act and

**WHEREAS**, based on the distribution guidelines from the US Department of Treasury, the following projects have been approved for the use of said funds:

- Transfer and Index Books in the Auditor & Record's Offices - not to exceed \$114,000
- Additional cameras in the Jail - not to exceed \$50,000
- Upgrade of the online real estate program for credit applications - not to exceed \$7,000
- NW Iowa YES Center for transportation and separation issues - not to exceed \$7,000
- Set aside funds for disaster preparedness - not to exceed \$30,000

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors endorses the disbursement of American Rescue Plan Act Funds for the items listed and authorizes the Auditor to make these payments as they are presented.
