March 29, 2022

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:03 a.m. with all members present except Dennis Vanden Hull who was available by phone.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by McDowell to appoint Dan Friedrichsen as Chair Pro-Tem. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Overmire, seconded by Steensma to approve the proceedings of March 22, 2022. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by McDowell, seconded by Steensma to approve the part-time employment of Amanda Verdoorn for training of the new Sheriff's Administrative Assistant. Her hourly rate will be \$35.00 per hour with no additional benefits. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Overmire, seconded by McDowell to adopt O'Brien County Resolution No. 2022-15; a resolution appointing the Sheriff's Administrative Assistant Marie Kruger and Jail Supervisor Tom Raymond as civil process servers. Motion carried by all ayes.

At 9:20 a.m. a hearing was held on the proposed amendment to the Fiscal 2022 County budget. There were no objects or comments presented. The Chair closed the hearing at 9:25 a.m.
