A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS FOR THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT.

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the 109 trillion-dollar American Rescue Plan Act and,

WHEREAS, O'Brien County applied for and has been received the first tranche of funds for the American Rescue Plan Act totaling \$1,335,679.50.


WHEREAS, the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors has reviewed some requests and determined some that will qualify for the American Rescue Plan Act and

WHEREAS, based on the distribution guidelines from the US Department of Treasury, the following additional projects have been approved fore the use of said funds:

- \$200,000 to purchase and install an X-ray body scanner with thermal sensor at the O'Brien County Law Enforcement Center. This will allow the Sheriff's Department to detect individuals that have fevers and may be infected with Covid-19. It will also give x-ray imaging to detect contraband such as weapons, keys, illegal narcotics and contraband. Use of this equipment will assist in keeping the inmates and jail staff healthier and safer.

BE IT RESOLVED that the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors endorses the disbursement of American Rescue Plan Act Funds for the items listed and authorizes the Auditor to make these payments as they are presented.
