

Resolution No. 2022-52
Resolution to Establish the Opioid Abatement Fund

WHEREAS, O'Brien County has been notified it will receive funds from a national opioid settlement involving a manufacturer and three distributors; and

WHEREAS, these funds may be used for opioid addiction prevention and treatment activities and other related programs per the Distributor Master Settlement Agreement and J&J Master Settlement Agreement.

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved, that the Opioid Abatement Fund (Fund 31) be established as a special revenue fund. This fund will be an interest bearing fund. All interest earned on these funds shall remain a part of the Opioid Abatement fund.

The above and foregoing resolution was adopted by the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors on the 2nd day of August, 2022.
