A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS FOR THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT.

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the 109 trillion-dollar American Rescue Plan Act and,

WHEREAS, O'Brien County applied for and has been received the first and second tranche of funds for the American Rescue Plan Act totaling \$2,671,359.

WHEREAS, the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors has reviewed requests and determined the eligibility to qualify for the American Rescue Plan Act and

WHEREAS, based on the distribution guidelines from the US Department of Treasury, the following additional projects have been approved for the use of said funds:

- \$15,000 as O'Brien County's share for the purchase a transport bus for the High Risk Entry and Arrest Team (HEAT) to transport the team members to respond to serious/dangerous situations.
- \$94,996.80 for the repair and preservation of Vital Records and Real Estate Records. These records are of great historic value.

BE IT RESOLVED that the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors endorses the disbursement of American Rescue Plan Act Funds for the items listed and authorizes the Auditor to make these payments as they are presented.
