

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

October 18, 2022

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:01 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Steensma to approve the proceedings of October 11, 2022. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by McDowell to adopt the following resolution. Motion carried by all ayes.

RESOLUTION 2022-63
RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, O'BRIEN COUNTY, IOWA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Section 306.41 of the Code of Iowa to temporarily close sections of road by formal resolution when they deem necessary for construction, maintenance, or natural disaster,

AND WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, County of O'Brien, have determined that the following section of road should be temporarily closed due to road construction:

Road Maintenance- PCC Patching
County Road: B-62 From Redwing Ave, To Warbler Ave.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the above described roads be closed temporarily in the manner described below.

"ROAD CLOSED" signs shall be placed on both ends of the described segment of road, and they shall remain in place until the construction is completed.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Overmire to support Operation Green Light for Veterans and declare November 7 – 13, 2022 as a time to salute and honor the service and sacrifice of our men and women in uniform transitioning from Active Service. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by McDowell, seconded by Overmire to approve Chris Haman as a full-time IT Technician at \$60,000 per year effective October 10, 2022. Motion carried by all ayes.

The Board discussed the continuation of the burn ban for the rural areas of O'Brien County. At this time the majority of the fire departments are not in favor of lifting the ban and conditions continue to be dry. The ban will be continued.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Friedrichsen to adjourn to October 25, 2022. Motion carried by all ayes.
