A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS FOR THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT.

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the 109 trillion-dollar American Rescue Plan Act and,

WHEREAS, O'Brien County applied for and received \$2,671,359 of funds for the American Rescue Plan Act funding.


WHEREAS, the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors has reviewed requests and determined some that will qualify for the American Rescue Plan Act and

WHEREAS, based on the distribution guidelines from the US Department of Treasury, the following additional projects have been approved for the use of said funds:

- \$14,982.96 for the O'Brien County Fair to make improvements to the open class building surrounding stage area.
- \$85,000 for Computer Networking upgrades for County Facilities
- \$5,205.13 Upgrading the virtual camera servers to physical servers for stability.

BE IT RESOLVED that the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors endorses the disbursement of American Rescue Plan Act Funds for the items listed and authorizes the Auditor to make these payments as they are presented.


