

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

November 21, 2023

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Vanden Hull to approve the proceedings of November 14, 2023. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Overmire, seconded by McDowell to approve the utility construction application of Premier Communications for placement of fiber optic cable on Oak Hill Ave. and Olive Ave. South of 270th Street to two residences. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Vanden Hull, seconded by Steensma to authorize the Chair to sign an agreement with Roorda Dairy, LLC for the maintenance of an irrigation pipe from Section 2, Caledonia Township to Section 34, Baker Township within the County right-of-way. Roorda Dairy, LLC is responsible for all cost of installation, maintenance and any issues that may arise from the pipe. Motion carried by all ayes.

The Board, as a Board of Canvassers, canvassed the 2nd tier results to include all of the other county results for the jurisdictions where O'Brien County is the Control County for the City/School Elections that were held on November 7, 2023 with the following declared elected: City Results: Sheldon Council at Large – Shantel Oostra; Sheldon 3rd Ward Council – Brad Hindt; School Results: Hartley-Melvin-Sanborn School Director District 1 – Kari Van Es; Director District 4 – Kyle McCarter; Sheldon School Director District at Large – Adam Sauer, Jessica Brink & Amy Sietstra; South O'Brien School Director 2 – Joshua Rausch; Director District 4 – Beth A. Sibenaller-Woodall; Director District 5 – Dallas Jalas and Director District at Large – John Beck. PUBLIC MEASURE QJ - Shall the Board of Directors of the Sheldon Community School District in the Counties of O'Brien, Osceola, Sioux and Lyon, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$19,160,000 to provide funds to be used together with sales tax bond proceeds to provide funds to remodel, repair, and improve the mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems at the high school, with related remodeling and improvements; to build, furnish, and equip additions to the high school, with related remodeling and improvements; to remodel, repair, and improve the east and north side entries; and to make related site improvements? Public Measure QK - Summary: To adopt a Revenue Purpose Statement specifying the use of revenues the South O'Brien Community School District will receive from the State of Iowa Secure an Advanced Vision for Education Fund. Yes – 564 No – 121 Measure carried.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by McDowell to appoint Erin Wilson to the Paullina Library Board for a term ending June 2026 and Sharla Rupert to the Paullina Library Board for the term ending June 2025. These appointments represent the rural area around Paullina per the City of Paullina's ordinance. Motion carried by all ayes.
