April 16, 2024

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Vanden Hull, seconded by Friedrichsen to approve the proceedings of April 9, 2024. Motion carried by all ayes.

At 9:05 a.m. fuel quotes were reviewed. The following submitted quotes: Producers Coop – 1 year \$609,168.50; 3 year - \$1,827,505.50; AgState – 1 year \$621,983.50; 3 year – no quote; Co-op Gas & Oil – 1 year \$611,583.50; 3 year - no quote; New Century FS – 1 year \$605,118.50; 3 year - \$1,815,355.50.

Moved by Vanden Hull, seconded by Friedrichsen to approve the fuel quote of New Century FS for 1 year at \$605,118.50 and to authorize the Chair to sign the contract. All ayes except McDowell. Motion carried.

Moved by McDowell, seconded by Vanden Hull to approve the quote of Denco in the amount of \$366,598.25 for crack filling, slurry leveling & sealing on several County blacktops. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Steensma to increase the hourly rate of the Engineering Tech II to the Engineering Tech I rate of \$31.67 effective April 26, 2024. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Vanden Hull, seconded by McDowell to approve the quote of Ziegler Cat for a 2024 Caterpillar 140 AWD motor grader at \$427,040.00 less trade in of a 2005 Cat 140H motor grader at \$64,000. Net price of \$363,040. Motion carried by all ayes.

RESOLUTION 2024-15

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY, IOWA

WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors has the authority to designate any highway as a through highway and requiring all vehicles to stop or yield the right-of-way before entering or crossing the same or designating any intersection as a stop or yield intersection and requiring all vehicles to stop at one or more entrances to such intersections;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors recognizes the need for placement of appropriate signs and relative appurtenances to facilitate the safe and efficient movement of traffic in accordance with the AASHTO Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the following traffic control devices be set to control traffic:

A STOP sign (R1-1), in accordance with Federal Highway Administration Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices at the following location:

A STOP AHEAD sign (W3-1), in accordance with Federal Highway Administration Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices at the following locations

A 35 MPH sign (R2-1), in accordance with Federal Highway Administration Manual on Uniform Traffic Control at the following locations.

The intersection of Redwood Avenue and 330th Street, near the Northeast Corner of Section 3 Summit Township, controlling eastbound traffic.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Steensma to approve claims to VISA for training expense and parts for a total of \$150.38 and claims to the following county libraries for the final allocation of Fiscal 2024 each in the amount of \$7,361.75: Hartley Public Library, Paullina Public Library, Primghar Public Library, Sanborn Public Library, Sheldon Public Library and Sutherland Public Library. Motion carried by all ayes.
