The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Vanden Hull to amend the agenda to include a road closing resolution for 280<sup>th</sup> Street. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Vanden Hull to approve the proceedings of May 21, 2024 and May 22, 2024. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by McDowell, seconded by Friedrichsen to approve the tile crossing application of Jo's Family Farms, LLC in Section 32, Franklin Township. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Steensma to approve the utility construction applications of Alliant Energy for a single phase cable under the road at 3135B Yellow Ave. and EverTek, Inc. to place fiber optic cable in the rural area south and west of Paullina. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Vanden Hull, seconded by McDowell to approve the quote of Ten Point Construction in the amount of \$299,002.90 for concrete patching at various locations. Motion carried by all ayes.

RESOLUTION 2024-26  
RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, O'BRIEN COUNTY, IOWA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Section 306.41 of the Code of Iowa to temporarily close sections of road by formal resolution when they deem necessary for construction, maintenance, or natural disaster,

AND WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, County of O'Brien, have determined that the following section of road should be temporarily closed due to road construction:

**Road Maintenance, PCC Patching.**

**Local Road 280<sup>th</sup> St. Between Northwest Ave. and Bypass 60.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the above described roads be closed temporarily in the manner described below.

"ROAD CLOSED" signs shall be placed on both ends of the described segment of road, and they shall remain in place until the construction is completed.
